



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## **When and where is the event?**

June 3, 2017 at Camp Liberty in New Liberty, Iowa, 4415 295th Street, New Liberty, Iowa 52765.

## **What's the age requirement?**

Runners need to be 14 or older to participate in the adult mud run. Runners 8-13 can participate in One Tough Cookie Jr. and runners under 7 can participate in Muddy Buddy.

## **How much does it cost?**

14+: \$60.00.

Kids: \$20.00.

## **How long is the adult mud run?**

One Tough Cookie is just over 3 miles. The race will include tons of mud and about 10 obstacles.

June 1 at 11:59 p.m.

Wear light-weight clothes that won't get heavy when wet and muddy. Old shoes are a must because it might be the last time that you wear them. You will also want to bring a clean set of clothes and shoes to change into after you are finished. Outdoor showers will be available at the end of the course.

## **What should I do with my stuff?**

We will have a bag check available.

## **How do I know my race time?**
